(A minor is any individual who is 17 years old or younger.)

I, _____, a minor student and a member of the Skyview High School Choir Program, and my parent/guardian, do hereby give permission to the Skyview Vocal Music Parent Association (SVMPA), to use my photograph or photographic image on their web site (www.skyviewchoirs.org). This permission is separate from, and does not include, any permission required by the Vancouver School District to display any photograph on their web site or any website under their jurisdiction.

It is agreed that the use of my photograph or photographic image shall in no way be used in any other forum other than for official SVMPA business and in promotion of the Choir Program at Skyview High School or other choir programs within the context of the Vancouver School District as promoted by the SVMPA. In consideration of my engagement as a model, and for other good and valuable consideration herein acknowledged as received, I hereby grant to the SVMPA and assigns, those acting with its authority and permission, the unrestricted right and permission to use any such photographs on their website or in conjunction with fund raising activities on items such as posters, fliers, presentations, etc. I hereby waive any right that I may have to inspect or approve the finished product and any copy (text) or other matter that may be used in connection therewith or the use to which it may be applied. I hereby release, discharge, and agree to save harmless the SVMPA as an organization including any officers, or members, the Vancouver School District, and Skyview High School and assigns, and all persons acting under its permission or authority or those for whom acting from any liability by virtue of any blurring, distortion, alteration, optical illusion, or use in composite form, whether intentional or otherwise, that may occur or be produced in the taking of said picture or in any subsequent processing thereof, as well as any publication thereof, including without limitation any claims for libel or invasion of privacy.

I do hereby release, acquit and forever discharge the SVMPA, its officers, members, attorneys, representatives, insurers and assigns from any and all demands, cause of action and/or judgments of whatsoever nature of character, past or future, known or unknown, whether in contract or in tort, whether for personal injuries, property damage, payments, fees, expenses, accounts receivable, credit, refunds, or any other monies due or to become due, or damages of any kind or nature, and whether arising from common law or statute, arising out of, in any way, the use of my photograph or photographic image for official University business. This release contains the entire agreement between the parties and shall be binding upon and inure to the benefit of the successors and assigns of the undersigned.

This agreement may be revoked by me and/or my parent/guardian at any time by submitting a letter in writing to the officers of the SVMPA. Such a revocation will go into effect within 10 business days of receipt by the SVMPA and any display of my image on their website within that 10 business day period.
